**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN  
BEACH MEASURE A IN THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION  
TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 5, 2019:**

**Whereas**, the Governing Board of the Manhattan Beach Unified School District understands the need for the City of Manhattan Beach to maintain a clean, safe, and well-maintained environment, and;

**Whereas**, the City of Manhattan Beach currently has one of the lowest transient occupancy tax (TOT) rates among neighboring cities such as El Segundo, Hermosa Beach, as well as other cities such as Inglewood, Santa Monica and Los Angeles, and;

**Whereas**, revenue generated by the updated TOT can be used to maintain and enhance community identified priorities, such as: maintaining all District-owned educational and recreational facilities that are available for the use of the City and the public, providing quick responses to 9-1-1 emergencies, providing police services including school site patrols and school resource services, maintaining streets around our schools, keeping public areas clean, and providing fire protection and emergency medical services to our students, staff, and community, and;

**Whereas**, fast emergency response times for 9-1-1 calls was identified as a top community priority. This measure could help ensure there are enough police officers, firefighters, and paramedics to respond quickly to 9-1-1 emergencies at our schools and neighboring community, and;

**Whereas**, all funds raised by this measure will be used to fund essential City services; no money can be taken by Sacramento, and;

**Whereas**, revenue generated by this measure will maintain the quality of life in Manhattan Beach by keeping the City clean, safe, and well-maintained.


**Therefore**, it is resolved that the Governing Board of Manhattan Beach Unified School District supports the Manhattan Beach City Council's Measure A at the General Municipal Election on Tuesday, March 5, 2019.


