



# Polliwog Park Dog Run



## Dog Run Rules MBMC 12.48.050

1. Dog run open daily  
November 1 - March 30: 6:30 AM - 8:00 PM  
April 1 - October 31: 6:30 AM - 9:00 PM
2. Dogs must be leashed outside Dog run and remain on designated "Dogs on Leash" paths of park
3. Dog run will be closed for obedience classes, special events and maintenance as posted
4. Occupancy limited to 20 dogs at any one time
5. If people are waiting, please leave after 15 minutes
6. No person may bring more than (2) dogs to the dog run at one time
7. All dogs must be currently licensed and vaccinated
8. Un-neutered/Un-spayed adult dogs (1 year or older) are NOT permitted
9. Aggressive dogs and dogs in heat are not permitted
10. Dog owners are liable for any injuries or damage caused by their dog(s)
11. Owner /custodian must be present and inside dog run at all times
12. Owner /custodian must supervise and clean up after their dog(s)
13. No food or treats allowed in dog run
14. Children under twelve (12) years of age must be supervised and accompanied by an adult in the dog run
15. Owner/custodian must have a leash available at all times
16. Owner/custodian must remove dog(s) that bark continuously
17. Owners are responsible for their dog's behavior

## Dog Run Etiquette

1. Wait to enter/exit the double-gated buffer area until gates are free of other dogs.
2. Keep dog(s) on leash until inside the first gate of the off leash dog run.
3. Remove the leash once you are inside the double-gated buffer area.
4. Upon exiting, leash your dog within the buffer area.
5. Make sure to close all gates immediately behind you.
6. Do not bring puppies under four (4) months old into dog run; it is a serious health risk.
7. Always keep a close eye on your dog(s).
8. If your dog becomes aggressive, unruly or disruptive to fellow dogs, please leave the dog run immediately.
9. If you see an owner not clean up after their dog(s), ask them politely to obey the rules.
10. We encourage owners to bring their own bags and maybe a few extra to leave for others. If you need a bag, feel free to take one from the dispenser.
11. Fill in all holes dug up by your dog.
12. No smoking in the dog run and park.
13. Help avoid accidents by being aware before throwing a ball for your dog(s).
14. Be careful when bringing children into the dog run. Some dogs may react aggressively to the high-pitched sound of children screaming. Not all dogs are friendly to children; teach children to ask permission before approaching a strange dog.
15. When visiting the play area after dark,

16. please bring a flashlight so that you will be able to clean up after your dog.
16. For the safety of your dog and their playing companions, remove prong collars before entering the dog run.
17. No strollers or babies allowed in the dog run.
18. Do not block pathways or entrance/exits.

***Help insure the success of this area by leaving it in better condition than you found it. Make a quick sweep of the area before you leave, picking up any mess that someone may have mistakenly left.***

## Dog Access in Polliwog Park

1. Dogs permitted on assigned Polliwog Park walk ways and in the Dog Run.
2. Dogs are restricted from pond walkway, amphitheater, play and fitness area.
3. Dogs are restricted from signed areas of the park during special events.
4. Dogs may not be tethered and must be on leash and under the control of owner.
